

TRIUMPHANT MAC ROBOTIC TEKKIES

The *Macau Anglican College* underwater robotics team represented Macau SAR and participated in the MATE International ROV Competition 2017 in Long Beach, California, U.S.A.

Among 39 teams from 17 countries around the world, they won the *Design Elegance award* - Best in Product Presentation, and the Chief Financial Officer - *Cerys Chan won the MVP in Product Presentation*. We are the first Macau school to achieve these awards in this event.

The teams battled it out from the 23rd of June to 25th of June 2017.

They were required to design and build a Remotely Operated Vehicle (ROV), which needs to perform a series of tasks underwater. It includes finding cargo containers that fell overboard, constructing an underwater tunnel and cleaning up contaminated sediments.

This competition encourages students to apply the knowledge gained from Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) to solve real world problems and is the most renowned competition in such category.
